The abstract should not exceed 500 words ((up to 500 words, Times New Roman, size 12 pt, interval 1,5 pt, full name in the right upper corner, title in bold centrally). The completed paper should also be communicated in the same format (with clear emphasis on the objectives, methodology, findings and conclusion/ policy implications).
